BA or Bachelor of Arts is an undergraduate degree course conferred for a study program in either social sciences or liberal arts or both. The duration of BA or Bachelor of Arts courses is normally three years divided into six semester.

The Bachelor of Arts or BA is a study program which normally has a duration of three years and this course can be broadly categorized into pass and honors courses. BA has been traditionally the most favorite bachelor's degree courses among the students of India who like to study arts in the higher level. After deciding to study B.A. at the pass or honors level, students can select from a big variety of study areas from the different options available before them. With regard to the earlier educational qualification of the candidate and the individual preference and skills of the student enroute for a particular course of study, there is a suitable curriculum for nearly every students choosing this course.

In order to be eligible for studying BA , students have to successfully pass their 10+2 level or Higher Secondary Examination in Arts, Science, or Commerce. It is a noteworthy feature that students with Commerce or Science at their higher secondary level can also study BA or Bachelor of Arts. The subject areas of BA or Bachelor of Arts include Philosophy, Economics, Political Science, Geography, Sociology, Literature, History, Psychology and so on. Following the successful accomplishment of BA, students can look for jobs or go for higher education such as postgraduate degree in any of the areas where BA has been completed.
