

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF COLLEGE

1. The college gives utmost priority for discipline and every student is bound to follow the rules and regulations of the college and maintain strict discipline.

2. Under disciplinary action, the Secretary/Principal is empowered to fine, suspend or even expel a student from the college in the interests of the institution.

3. Students are not permitted to possess or use Mobile Phones inside the class rooms.

4. Ragging of any sort is strictly prohibited. Students found guilty of this offence are liable for severe punishment including expulsion from Institution, Hostel and matter will be referred to police as the same has been declared as a criminal offence by the Government.

4. BROWSING ILLEGAL SITES IS NOT ALLOWED DURING LAB HOURS. Staff and students are not allowed to misuse the internet facilities.

5. No one will be allowed to listen to Music from any device inside the college campus.

6. Every Student shall conduct himself/herself in such a way to cause no disturbance to the working of the classes or to fellow students.

7. CONSUMPTION of any form of narcotics is STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE HOSTEL AND COLLEGE CAMPUS.

8. No function shall be arranged by the students in the hostel or college campus without prior permission from the Secretary/Principal.

9. Writing on walls, pillars, bath rooms, and furniture or black boards is strictly prohibited. The cost of any damage, if caused to college property will be charged to the accounts of the students responsible for the damage in addition to disciplinary action.

10. Students are advised to switch off fans and lights when they leave the office or class rooms.

11. Furniture in the class rooms should not be moved or displaced.

12. Students are not allowed to attend classes or any college function wearing causal dresses.

13. No students shall remain in the hostel during class-hours unless he/she is sick and is permitted to be on leave.

14. Students have to take without fail all the necessary items such as hall ticket, admit card, pen, pencil, calculator, Scale, rubber, etc., to the test/exam hall.

75% of attendance is mandatory for all students. In the event of continued poor performance in internal tests and poor class attendance by any student, the Secretary/Principal has the authority to withhold permission for him/her to write the university examinations or late fine will be implemented for deflate students.

Attendance & Leave of Absence:

1. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each period. Late comers shall enter class-room only with the permission of the teacher.

2. Students who leave class-room after roll call without the permission of the teacher are liable to severe punishment.
3. Impersonation at roll call will be considered as serious offence.
4. Application for leave of absence for more than 4 days due to illness should be supported by medical certificates.
5. Students absenting themselves from the college for more than fifteen consecutive working days without satisfactory explanation will have their names removed from the roll and treated as temporary removal.
6. A student sent out from the class by a teacher shall lose the attendance for the duration he is out.
7. Disciplinary action including removal from the rolls will be taken against those who repeatedly absent themselves on insufficient grounds.

4. Ragging of any sort is strictly prohibited. Students found guilty of this offence are liable for severe punishment including expulsion from Institution, Hostel and matter will be referred to police as the same has been declared as a criminal offence by the Government.

4. BROWSING ILLEGAL SITES IS NOT ALLOWED DURING LAB HOURS. Staff and students are not allowed to misuse the internet facilities.

5. No one will be allowed to listen to Music from any device inside the college campus.

6. Every Student shall conduct himself/herself in such a way to cause no disturbance to the working of the classes or to fellow students.

7. CONSUMPTION of any form of narcotics is STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE HOSTEL AND COLLEGE CAMPUS.

8. No function shall be arranged by the students in the hostel or college campus without prior permission from the Secretary/Principal.

9. Writing on walls, pillars, bath rooms, and furniture or black boards is strictly prohibited. The cost of any damage, if caused to college property will be charged to the accounts of the students responsible for the damage in addition to disciplinary action.

10. Students are advised to switch off fans and lights when they leave the office or class rooms.

11. Furniture in the class rooms should not be moved or displaced.

12. Students are not allowed to attend classes or any college function wearing casual dresses.

13. No students shall remain in the hostel during class-hours unless he/she is sick and is permitted to be on leave.

14. Students have to take without fail all the necessary items such as hall ticket, admit card, pen, pencil, calculator, Scale, rubber, etc., to the test/exam hall.

75% of attendance is mandatory for all students. In the event of continued poor performance in internal tests and poor class attendance by any student, the Secretary/Principal has the authority to withhold permission for him/her to write the university examinations or late fine will be implemented for deflate students.

Attendance & Leave of Absence:

1. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each period. Late comers shall enter class-room only with the permission of the teacher.

2. Students who leave class-room after roll call without the permission of the teacher are liable to severe punishment.
3. Impersonation at roll call will be considered as serious offence.
4. Application for leave of absence for more than 4 days due to illness should be supported by medical certificates.
5. Students absenting themselves from the college for more than fifteen consecutive working days without satisfactory explanation will have their names removed from the roll and treated as temporary removal.
6. A student sent out from the class by a teacher shall lose the attendance for the duration he is out.
7. Disciplinary action including removal from the rolls will be taken against those who repeatedly absent themselves on insufficient grounds.

Library and other Facilities

The College has separate library and reading room facility for students. There are more than 10,000 books. The students can borrow two books of their choice per week. In case the books are needed for a longer time, they can be renewed for one more week. Magazines are made available in the reading room for the students for enrichment of knowledge.

मयुराक्षी नदी के तट पर एक पिछड़े एवं उपेक्षित क्षेत्र में अवस्थित यह महाविद्यालय रानीश्वर सह समीपवर्ती क्षेत्र के शैक्षिक परिवृत के उन्नयन में अपना अलग अस्तित्व रखता है। इस महाविद्यालय की स्थापना से पूर्व डा० सनत कुमार साहा सफल शल्य चिकित्सक के सतत् प्रयास से हाबुलाल साहा महाविद्यालय की स्थापना रानीबहाल में सन् 1984 में हुई। परन्तु कुछ विशेष कारण वंश एक वर्ष के उपरांत उक्त महाविद्यालय प्रबंधन के साथ अनवन होने के कारण कुशल एवं सफल राजनीतिज्ञ शिक्षानुरागी स्वर्गीय अश्विनी कुमार घोष, हाबुलाल साहा महाविद्यालय के प्राचार्य श्री बैद्यनाथ मुस्ताफी एवं मेरे अग्रणी भूमिका एवं स्वर्गीय अनादी नाथ राय, स्व० सुनिति कुमार घोष, स्व० अखतार हुसैन खान, स्व० अब्दुल मन्नान खान, स्व० शैलेजा सिंहा, स्व० असिता रंजन चटर्जी, स्व० सुधीर राय, श्री अहमद हुसैन खान, श्री वेनीमाधव लायेक, श्री रामपद पाल आदि समाजसेवीओं तथा रानीश्वर के प्रबुध नागरिकों के सहयोग से इस महाविद्यालय की स्थापना सन् 1985 में हुई। प्रारंभिक समय से मेरे दो सहयोगी प्रो० दिलीप कुमार मण्डल एवं प्रो० मु० रेजाउद्दीन मेरे साथ - साथ इस महाविद्यालय की स्थापना में महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका निभाया है। शिक्षण के प्रथम चरण में इंटर स्तर के अध्यापन का श्री गणेश कला एवं वाणिज्य संकायों में किया गया और प्रारंभिक काल में ही महाविद्यालय ने अप्रत्याशित सफलता प्राप्त कर जनमानस में अपनी उल्लेखनीय छबी अंकित कर ली है। परवर्ती समय में इंटर विज्ञान संकाय की पढ़ाई प्रारम्भ की गयी एवं तीनों संकायों में विद्यार्थियों की संख्या बढ़ती गयी जिससे महाविद्यालय अपने सर्वांगीण विकास की ओर बढ़ते जा रहा है। वर्ष 2006 में विज्ञान इंटर में इस महाविद्यालय ने झारखण्ड टॉपर प्रदान किया है। सत्र 1988 - 1990 से स्नातक स्तरीय प्रतिष्ठा की पढ़ाई भी तीनों
